Empowering people to learn new skills, overcome adversity and gain improved financial and food security has always been a part of our mission. Harvest Manitoba's training program provides paid skills training and support for Manitobans facing food insecurity which have challenges in entering the workforce.



This 6-week program provides a combination of classroom learning, soft skills and wrap-around services, hands-on work in the Harvest Manitoba warehouse/distribution facility, and practical training in private sector businesses around Winnipeg.

This program aims to bridge the gap into regular employment that will ultimately support individuals and families with the income they need to improve their financial security, food security and wellbeing.

THIS TRAINING PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- Classes to grow skills
- Industry certificates
- Real-life workplace experience
- Resume and job search support
- Letters of reference
- Financial assistance during the program
- Access to other support services and programs during and after the completion of the program

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Unemployed and actively looking for employment
- Able to attend and participate independently for the entire program
- At least 18 years of age
- Able to attend and participate for the entire length of the program
- Proficient in English for classroom and workplace discussion
- Can lift 50 lbs. and work an 8-hour shift
- Eligible to work in Manitoba

How can your organization support this program?

PROVIDING PARTICIPANTS REFERRAL

Pre-screen candidates to ensure they meet minimum criteria

PROVIDING EMPLOYABILITY SKILLS SESSIONS

- Arranging with Harvest mock individual or group job interviews for the participants.
- Coaching and giving feedback after the exercises to each participant.
